# RATIONALE

Devices such as Portable Bluetooth Speakers cause disruption, and are not a necessary item at school.

### AIMS

To minimise disruption to the learning of all students and create a safe school environment.

# POLICY

Portable Bluetooth Speakers are **NOT** permitted at school. A breach of these procedures may lead to a *Formal* 

*Caution*. Further breaches, and/or breaches that cause major and deliberate disruption, may lead to a *Suspension* 

## for Continued Disobedience.

# CONSEQUENCES FOR BREACH OF THIS

#### **CLASSROOM BREACH** of the Portable Bluetooth Speaker Procedures
