

This policy was first published **01 March 2019**.

### RATIONALE

Devices such as Portable Bluetooth Speakers cause disruption, and are not a necessary item at school.

### AIMS

To minimise disruption to the learning of all students and create a safe school environment.

### POLICY

Portable Bluetooth Speakers are **NOT** permitted at school. A breach of these procedures may lead to a **Formal Caution**. Further breaches, and/or breaches that cause major and deliberate disruption, may lead to a **Suspension** for **Continued Disobedience**.

### CONSEQUENCES FOR BREACH OF THIS

#### CLASSROOM BREACH of the Portable Bluetooth Speaker Procedures

##### First Breach (per lesson):

- non-verbal cue
- reminder of *Procedures*

##### Second Breach (per lesson):

- student issued a *Surrender Slip* and directed to report to the front office
- teacher will enter the incident on SENTRAL => Negative Incidents => Portable Bluetooth Speaker Breach
- Parent contacted => teacher outlines procedures and requests the support of the parent

##### Refusal to Cooperate (including further breaches):

- notification to Head Teacher of Faculty  
=> Letter of **Formal Caution**  
=> Parent contacted => HT outlines procedures and requests the support of parent

#### MOVING BETWEEN CLASS

##### Breach:

- non-verbal cue
- reminder of *Policy*

##### Refusal to Cooperate or Breach causing Disruption

- notification to Deputy Principal  
=> Letter of **Formal Caution**  
=> Parent contacted => DP outlines policy and requests support of parent

#### CORRIDOR and/or PLAYGROUND BREACH of the Portable Bluetooth Speaker Policy

##### Breach:

- non-verbal cue
- reminder of *Policy*

##### Refusal to Cooperate or Breach causing Disruption

- notification to Head Teacher on duty
- => Letter of **Formal Caution**  
=> Parent contacted => HT outlines policy and requests the support of parent
