

Student Representation Procedures

These procedures were implemented 14 Mar 2017 and revised Aug 2018.

RATIONALE

Eagle Vale High School is committed to providing a range of extra-curricular offerings as part of a holistic approach to student development; all students are encouraged to participate in the full range of opportunities available.

In addition, EVHS is committed to the philosophy and practices that underpin Restorative Practices. As such, we view involvement in extra-curricular activities as an opportunity for students to learn and grow.

PROCEDURES

To be eligible to participate and represent EVHS in extra-curricular activities, students must be able to demonstrate commitment to our high expectations through their **ATTENDANCE**, **BEHAVIOUR**, completion of **COURSE WORK**, and wearing of **UNIFORM** with pride. Improvements in these areas will also be taken into consideration when deciding a student's eligibility to represent the school.

The following checks (5 – weeks prior to the event) will be used to determine a student's eligibility:

Overall attendance (for the current school term) ≥ 85%, AND
 minimal Negative Incidents for the five weeks prior, AND
 wears school uniform
 unresolved NESA Warning Letters
 improved behaviour (reduced negative incidents), AND/OR
 improved unexplained lateness / pxp attendnace, AND/OR
 improved wearing of school uniform
 Formal Caution or Level 3 (that is current), OR
 persistant refusal to wear school uniform, OR
 a pattern of SERIOUS negative incidents

PROCEDURES

Five days prior to the event, the HT & organising teacher will complete the checks and compile a COLOUR CODED list to forward to DP Leon for discussion. DP Leon will table the list at Senior Executive meeting for final approval.

- GREEN: student has met the criteria => eligible to represent the school
- AMBER: student is demonstrating a pattern of improvement OR a willingness to enter a contract for improvement => opportunity to work with the student on an individual basis to set short term goals/contract so that the student is deemed eligible
- RED: student is excluded from the event

A student can be withdrawn at any point in the final lead up to the event e.g. a formal caution or suspension A student that is ineligible to participate will be notified by the organising teacher.
